



Last year, the students at Tulle Ade School experienced a learning environment no child should sit through.

Pupils studied in dark classrooms made from mud. Few had desks to sit at, so they spent entire lessons perched on logs or sitting on the bare, dusty ground, scribbling on notepads balanced on their knees.

Many did not enroll in school, and even less stayed. For those that completed Grade 5, they had no choice to drop out: the school did not cater for Grades 5 and above.

Now, that has all changed, thanks to you.

With your support, we've opened a brand new school for the community and children of Tulle Ade, complete with comfortable classrooms, gender-segregated latrines, a library, early childhood education centre, and playground. It caters for children from 0 Class to Grade 8

We've equipped the school with science gear, sports equipment, library books and other supplies. We're training the teachers to better engage their students. We're working local leaders to mobilize the community and champion education for all children.

## The community of Tulle Ade is already delivering on their commitment to educate their children.

When imagine1day first visited Tulle Ade School in 2015, just 341 children were enrolled. Around 16% of students were dropping out of school every single year, with girls more likely to leave.

Your support didn't just allow us to build a school – it's allowing us to equip a community with the tools and skills to make education available for all. We're training 17 community leaders and teachers on enrollment strategies, community engagement, school management, and teaching methods.

Though we have only just opened the school, we are already witnessing impressive results. 556 children now attend Tulle Ade – that's a 63% increase in the school roll in 18 months. And by the end of 2016, not a single child had dropped out.

It's not just getting kids in school that counts: it making sure they have a quality education. Already the average GPA has risen from 64.4 in 2015 to 72.9 today.

With a modern school now in place, the future looks even brighter.
